## CRAWL FOR THE CURE 2010

In October of 2007 the New Jersey Jeep Association held our first Crawl for the Cure, an off-road event to support the fight against cancer. Approximately 80 vehicles and 150 people attended, helping us raise just over \$5,400.00. In 2008, approximately 125 vehicles and 160 people attended, raising just over \$7,500. This past October of 2009, approximately 150 vehicles and 300 people attended, helping us raise just over \$12,000.00. All donations were split between the American Cancer Society and Susan G. Komen For the Cure.

This October 23rd, the New Jersey Jeep Association will be holding its 4th Annual Crawl for the Cure at Rausch Creek Off Road Park in Joliet, PA. The Club hopes to continue the growth and success of this event so that even more funds can be raised to help fight this disease.
